

Motorized Vehicle Display Guidelines

Load-in - Set Up - Load-out

Motorized vehicles are defined as any type of vehicle which is propelled by an internal combustion engine using Class 1 or Class 2 fuel, such as but not limited to: automobiles, trucks, motorcycles, aircraft and watercraft.

All motorized vehicles which are displayed shall have all batteries disconnected at the "Hot" lead. The lead shall be safely secured to prevent contact with the battery.

Fuel tanks in vehicles on display shall not exceed one-quarter tank or 5 gallons (19 L) (whichever is least).

All motor vehicle tanks containing fuel shall be furnished with locking caps or sealed with tape to prevent inspection by viewers. Tractors, chainsaws, generators and other such fuel powered equipment shall be safe-guarded in a similar manner. A protective floor mat, is required while on display, loading in and loading out.

Vehicles, boats or other motors shall not be fueled or defueled within the building.

Upon entering, Visqueen must be laid under vehicle and must remain under the vehicle during the entire time that it is on display. A drip pan must also be used at all times under the engine/transmission and any other possible leak sites.

An Embassy Suites Hotel representative must be present during the load-in and load-out of motorized vehicles.

Gas or diesel powered vehicles are not permitted for movement of exhibits or materials into the function spaces. Propane powered vehicles are permitted.
